Traditional Protocol for Today's Celebration
WELCOME! AKWAABA! HOTEPI! EKAABO! BYENVINI!

We are honored that you have joined us today. Your energy completes our celebration.

Our celebrations are participatory. We invite you to join us in the singing, dancing, and clapping. Your involvement helps to facilitate healing for yourself, your family, and the community.

As with most religious ceremonies there are traditional customs that are followed that enhance the energy, these customs may be referred to as our protocol. We are appreciative if you are mindful of the following:

1. There is NO picture taking or video recording allowed. Please do not post on ANY part of this sacred event on social media websites. Including but not limited to Facebook, Twitter, Photobucket, Flickr, Shutterfly, email, or text messaging.
2. Please greet with your right hand unless asked to do otherwise;
3. When libation is poured, you may kneel, bow your head, remove your shoes or take whatever position is appropriate for you when giving prayer;
4. When participating in the dancing, begin by acknowledging the drum (by touching the floor in front of it), and any spiritual energy, Priest, Chief or Queen Mother (by placing your right hand over your left, palms up) that you may pass as you join the dancing circle.
5. When dancing in the circle or greeting any spiritual energy, please remove your eyeglasses, shoes, and sock.
6. Females who are on their menses: - should not extend their hand to greet due to the requirements of the deities and spiritual houses in many regions. If a hand is extended to you, you may nod your head in acknowledgement; you are also asked not to dance within the circle, also due to above stated requirements.

Clap! Sing! Dance! Enjoy yourself!
